

A Marriage Enrichment Exercise

John Gray, author of <u>Men Are From Mars and Women Are From Venus</u> and several other <u>Mars and Venus</u> books, says that the most important thing that a man can say to his wife is "I love you," and the most important words that a wife can say to her husband are "Thank you." That is, he says, because women want love and men want appreciation.


